
# City-Wide Leaf Pick Up



## FALL 2024 LEAF PICK UP DATES: OCTOBER 21 - NOVEMBER 30

The bulk leaf program will have equipment running in both Zone 1 & Zone 2 during the leaf program.

It is still asked that **leaves be placed in the boulevard by Monday** at 7 a.m. in both **Zones** to assure that leaves are collected.

### WEATHER PERMITTED PROGRAM:

- If a high accumulation of snow and/or ice takes place during this schedule, the leaf pick up program will not be extended.
- The leaf program does not guarantee a set number of pick ups, nor does it guarantee what day of the week the leaves will be picked up.

#### LEAF PICK UP:

- No leaf pick up will take place November 28th due to the Thanksgiving holiday.
- Leaf pick up can occur ANY day of the week depending on the volume of leaves and the weather.
- If there is a high accumulation of snow and/or an ice event, no leaf pick up will take place on those days.
- Do not Rake leaves into the street!
- Do not mix leaves with any other debris (such as sticks, grass, or plants.) Leaves will not be picked up if mixed with debris.
- Do not block leaf piles with vehicles or have vehicles in close proximity of leaf piles. Leaf piles blocked by vehicles WILL NOT be picked up.
- Once leaf trucks have been on your street, leaf trucks will not return until the next pass through.

#### OTHER DISPOSAL OPTIONS:

Leaves can be put into yard waste bags or containers marked with an "X" for pick up on the regular residential trash day through **December 12**.
